In most cases, for electronic tax return filers, 2017 IRS income tax return information is available for the IRS DRT or the IRS Tax Return Transcript within 2–3 weeks after the 2017 electronic IRS income tax return has been accepted by the IRS. Generally, for filers of the 2017 paper IRS income tax returns, the 2017 IRS income tax return information is available for the IRS DRT or the IRS Tax Return Transcript within 6–8 weeks after the 2017 paper IRS income tax return has been received by the IRS. If you need more information about using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool or obtaining an IRS Tax Return Transcript, contact your financial aid administrator at your school.

- A 2017 IRS Tax Return Transcript (that will only include information from the original tax return and does not have to be signed), or
  any other IRS tax transcript(s) that includes all of the income and tax information required to be verified; and
- A signed copy of the 2017 IRS Form 1040X, "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS.
